HOW TO REACH THE MEETING VENUE

Centro Pastorale Paolo VI

Via Gezio Calini, 30 - Brescia

By car

From A4 Milan-Brescia-Venice or A21 Piacenza-Brescia highways

Take the exit at “Brescia Centro” and follow the map to the Centro Paolo VI Car can be left in the two reserved parking areas accessed through Via Callegari.

By train

Bus 1, 2 and 18 depart from the train station directed towards the Centro Storico (Downtown). Bus stops in Via S. Martino della Battaglia or Corso Magenta are at a short walking distance from the Centro Paolo VI. It takes about 10 minutes to reach the congress by taxi from the railway station.

By plane

Milan Linate, Milan Malpensa, Bergamo Orio al Serio and Verona international airports are connected by trains or shuttle buses to Brescia.
